CARDIGAN PATTERN

1. This Cardigan is working from the bottom to the top, the sleeves are worked directly (pick up) around armholes.
2. To have a perfect edge for the left & right front, don't knit the first stitch of the right & left side.
3. Please read through the entire pattern to familiarise yourself with its construction before starting to knit.

BLUEPRINT

YARN

11 (11) 12 balls Merino Max Cleckheaton
(col.3) - 495 (495) 540m

NEEDLES

1 pair of needles 10mm/US15
1 tapestry needle

GAUGE

(needles 10mm, garter stitch)
10x10cm
10 stitches x 18 rows

FINISHED DIMENSIONS

89 (101) 102 cm / 52 (53) 55,5 cm
(sleeves : 47 (49) 50,5cm)

SKILL LEVEL

easy (for beginners)

PATTERN

BACK

With a set of needles 10mm cast on 43 (45) 51 sts. Work in garter stitch for about 36 cm and cast off 1 st on each side to place armholes :

R1 : cast off 1 stitch, knit to end

R2 : cast off 1 stitch, knit to end

You obtain 41 (43) 49 stitches.

Knit to 52 (53) 55 cm.

Next row : Knit 14 (15) 17 stitches, cast off 15 (15) 17 stitches, Knit 14 (15) 17 stitches

Leave the 14 (15) 17 sts of each side on a spare needle of some scrap yarn

LEFT FRONT

With a set of needles 10mm cast on 22 (24) 26 sts. Work in garter stitch for 36 cm and cast off 1 st on the right side to place armholes. You obtain 21 (23) 25 sts.

Knit for about 48 cm and cast off 7 (8) 8 stitches on the left side, you obtain 14 (15) 17 sts.

Knit 6 rows and leave the 14 (15) 17 sts on a spare needle of some scrap yarn.

RIGHT FRONT

With a set of needles 10mm cast on 22 (24) 26 sts. Work in garter stitch for 36 cm and cast off 1st on the left side to place armholes. You obtain 21 (23) 25 sts.

Knit for about 48 cm and cast off 7 (8) 8 stitches on the right side, you obtain 14 (15) 17 sts.

Knit 6 rows and leave the 14 (15) 17 sts on a spare needle of some scrap yarn

To join shoulders, use the 3 needles Bind off 14 (15) 17 stitches from each the left & right front and back piece on each side. Hold your 2 needles both right sides are held together. With a 3rd needle, knit one stitch through the next stitch on both needles at the same time, repeat, knit the next stitch through the stitches on both needles. Then pull the first stitch over the second stitch, just as you would for a standard bind off, and repeat across the row until all stitches are bound off.

SLEEVES x2

With a pair of needles 10mm picked up around armholes 33 (36) 38 stitches.

Knit 14 rows and decrease 1 st on each side :

Decrease row : Knit 1 stitch, Knit 2 stitches together, Knit to last 3 stitches, Knit 2 stitches together, Knit 1 stitch.

Knit 7 rows and decrease 1 st on each side :

*Decrease row : Knit 1 stitch, Knit 2 stitches together, Knit to last 3 stitches, Knit 2 stitches together, Knit 1 stitch.

Knit 7 rows* and repeat 4 times

You obtain 22 (24) 27 stitches.

At 47 (49) 50 cm bind off. Join each side in a gentle sewing.

FINISHING

Submerge your fabric in water, gently squeezing out any air bubbles so that the piece can remain under water without being held there. Soak work for 30 minutes, allowing your piece to become completely saturated.

Drain the sink and remove work. Squeeze out excess water from your work, taking care not to twist or wring fabric. Roll your work between two (clean) bath towels and firmly press the towel roll. This will aid in removing moisture from the knitted piece. Remove piece from towels. Place your piece on an appropriate surface. Allow to air dry completely before removing.
